



# CARERS SUPPORT NETWORKS 2011

Grants of up to £3,000 available for projects that promote greater support for carers.

This programme forms part of the growing initiative to provide carers with greater support and is intended to support Heart of Birmingham Teaching Primary Care Trust (HoBtPCT) in implementation of the Department of Health Carers Strategy (2009) and delivery of the following outcomes:

- Carers will have access to the services they need to support them in their caring role
- Carers will be able to have a life of their own
- Carers will be supported to stay mentally and physically well

There are specific outcomes for this intervention programme that HoBtPCT are interested in seeing from applicants, which are to:

- Provide opportunities for carers to develop new peer support networks
- Provide existing networks with support and/or funding to expand opportunities to a greater number of carers
- Provide support for carers and/or carers networks to enable them to access other sources of support and funding

## Eligibility

You or your organisation must be based in the HoBtPCT area, which covers the following wards: Aston, Handsworth Wood, Ladywood, Lozells and East Handsworth, Nechells, Oscott, Perry Barr, Soho, Sparkbrook and Springfield.
